

PETER MIDDUP LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

INFORMATION PACK

This award honours individuals who have made significant, long-lasting contributions to the facilities management industry. It recognises those who have demonstrated exceptional dedication, leadership, and innovation throughout their careers, shaping the industry and setting high standards for others to follow. By celebrating these trailblazers, the award not only acknowledges their achievements but also inspires future generations of professionals to strive for excellence and make impactful contributions to the facilities management sector.

<u>Eligibility</u>

Entrants can be self-nominated or nominated by another colleague or associate. They should be able to demonstrate many years of service to the facilities management industry.

What to submit

- The entry form (submitted digitally through the website)
- A submission of up to 1,500 words (as a Word document, PDF or Powerpoint presentation) plus a 250-word summary.

What the submission should include:

- 1. Nominee's Biography:
 - Detailed professional background, including career milestones and key positions held.
- 2. Career Achievements:
 - Summary of significant contributions and accomplishments in the facilities management industry.
 - Examples of innovative practices or solutions introduced by the nominee.
- 3. Leadership and Influence:
 - Description of the nominee's leadership style and impact on teams and organisations.
 - Evidence of mentorship and development of other professionals in the industry.
- 4. Industry Impact:
 - Explanation of how the nominee has influenced the facilities management industry as a whole.

- Contributions to industry standards, best practices, and professional organisations.
- 5. Client and Peer Testimonials:
 - Letters of recommendation or testimonials from clients, colleagues, and industry peers.
 - Specific examples of the nominee's positive impact on clients and the industry.
- 6. Awards and Recognitions:
 - List of previous awards, honours, and recognitions received by the nominee.
 - Any notable publications, presentations, or contributions to industry knowledge.
- 7. Community and ESG Involvement:
 - Description of the nominee's involvement in community service and corporate social responsibility initiatives.
 - Examples of how the nominee has promoted sustainability and ethical practices.
- 8. Supporting Documentation:
 - Any additional documents, such as project reports, case studies, or media coverage, that support the nominee's achievements and contributions.

The winner will be announced at the PFM Awards on 5 November 2025. Finalists are not announced publicly for this category.
